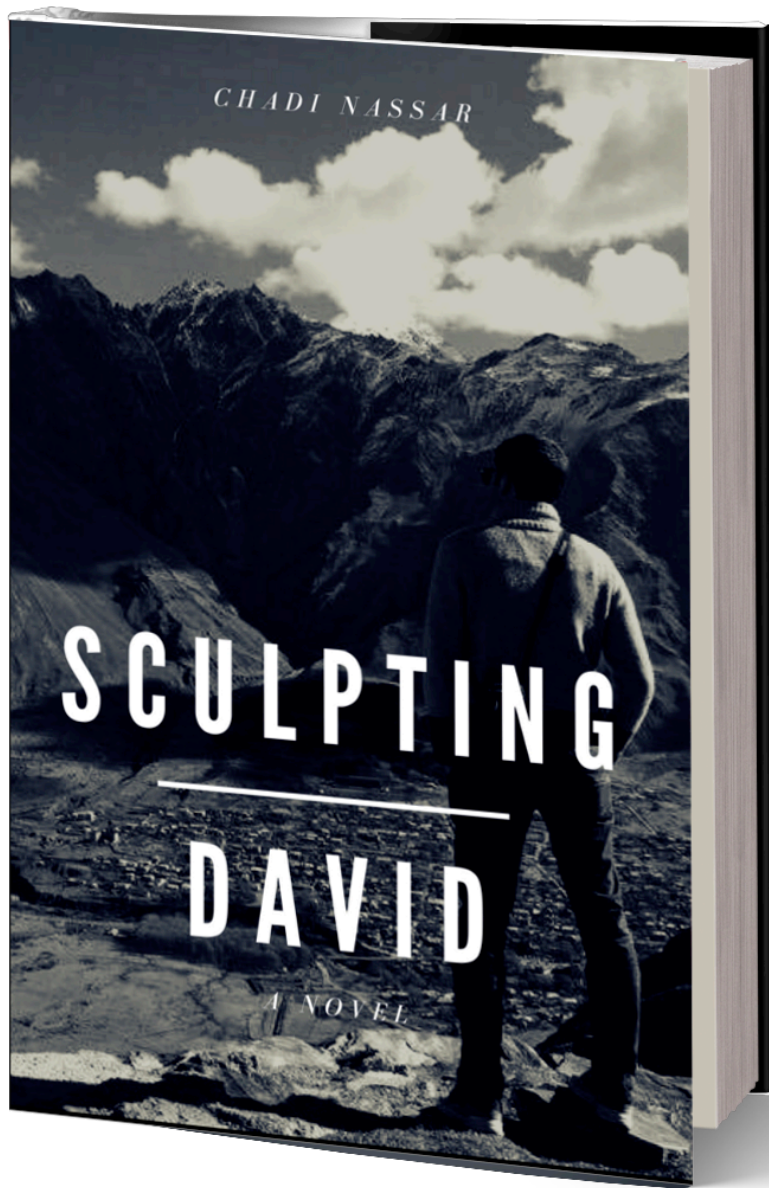

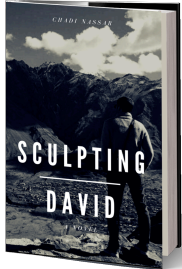
Book Bio
